Here’s How to Make it Stop:

Revoke Your Card

If you signed a union authorization card but have changed your mind, use this QR code for a sample message requesting to revoke your signature.



Don’t Sign a Card

You have the right to sign or not sign a union authorization card. You have the right to tell union organizers you are not interested in unionizing. You have the right to say, “No.”



You have the right to campaign against NNU.

You have the right to tell other nurses you don’t want a union at MedStar Georgetown University Hospital.
